Important Notes for Affected Users

- QliqCONNECT credentials will continue to be utilized to log into QliqCHAT

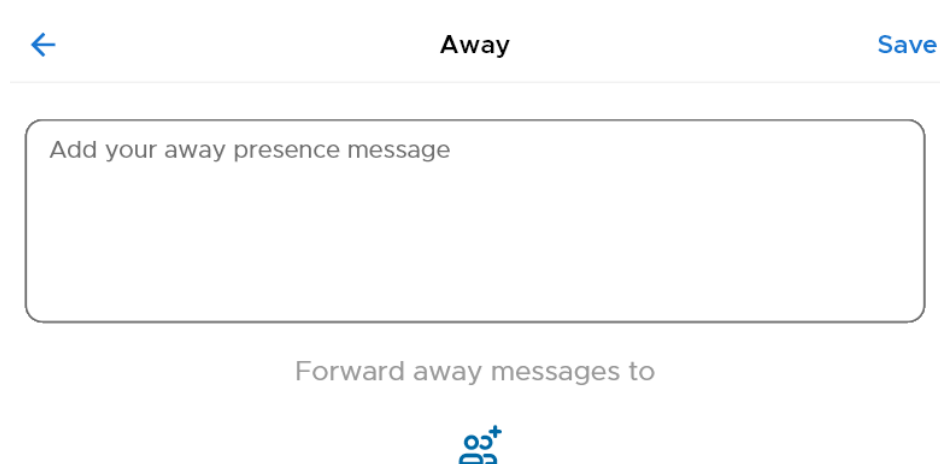
- First-time login will load 7 days of historical messages (same scenario of installing QliqCONNECT on a new device)
- Users will not need to uninstall and reinstall the QliqCHAT app when updating to newer builds.

What's New

1. Added an away message to users in the conversation details view. To access this click on your avatar and then select away.



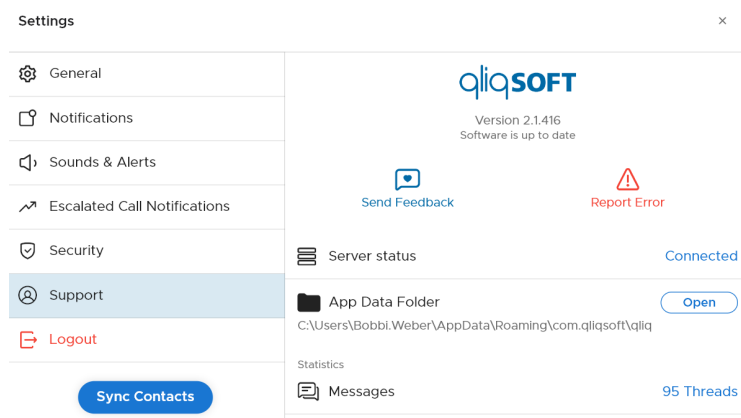

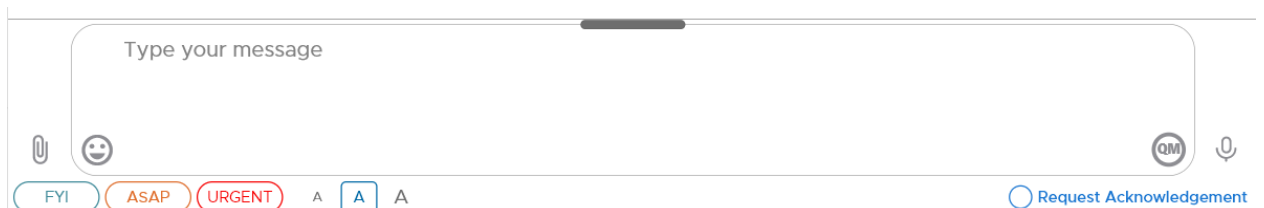
2. Added a button in the Support section of Settings to open an app folder on a computer



3. Added ability to change the width of the chat list column and chat views. To do this, click on the vertical gray bar at the top of the message and drag it to your preferred size.

Improvements

1. Added a toolbar to the PDF preview that allows to zoom in/out without a touchpad
2. Improved quality of the PDF preview on Windows
3. Added the possibility to expand long conversation subjects in the conversation details window. To do this, click on the horizontal gray bar at the top of the message and drag it to your preferred size.



4. Spell check is hovering over an exact text that it suggests to correct
5. Archived conversations are now synced for the same user account for when individuals use different devices and platforms
6. Improved overall app speed and responsiveness
7. There is an indicator in Settings to show whether QliqSTOR Archiving is enabled or disabled

8. When a user selects "Remember Password", the user will be automatically logged in but the password will not be viewable

Bug Fixes

1. Fixed an issue that prevented a small subset of users from logging in to build 402
2. Previewing XLSX files on Windows does not slow down the responsiveness of the application anymore
3. Fixed database error happening for some users on Windows when updating the app to the latest version
4. Messages now have the same status for users logged in under the same account on different devices
5. Message status priority is now displayed correctly when statuses are updated at the same time
6. Decreased log file size
7. The visual display of an audio attachment has been reduced to 60% of the screen width
8. All PDFs now upload into QliqSTOR
9. Administrators now have the option to delete PDF files in the QliqSTOR folder
10. Audio files can now be recorded and played for Mac users
11. Users no longer intermittently get a failed to decrypt message
12. Printing a PDF directly from QliqCHAT on Windows is possible if Acrobat Reader, Foxit Reader, or SumatraPDF is installed on the computer. There is no additional set up required.
13. All characters are now recognized in conversation search on Windows
14. Attachments larger than 10 Mb display previews and thumbnails correctly
15. Messages sent on one user device and recalled on a different user device are seen as recalled for all message recipients
16. Messages sent through the messaging API now show who sent them

Feature Update: Printing Documents on Windows

We've restored the ability to print documents directly from the QliqCHAT app on Windows. Previously, this feature was disabled due to some issues, but it's now available again with the following updates:

How It Works:

- You can now print documents through the following PDF viewers:
 - **Adobe Acrobat Reader:** Fully supported, with full print settings available.
 - **Foxit Reader:** Partially supported; prints directly to the default printer without showing print settings.

What You Need to Do:

1. **Install a Supported PDF Viewer:**
 - [Adobe Acrobat Reader](#)
 - [Foxit Reader](#)
2. **Set Your Chosen Viewer as the Default for PDF Files:**
 - Go to **Settings > Apps > Default apps**.
 - Type **.pdf** in the search bar, then select your preferred viewer from the list.
 - Make sure the viewer is set as the default for opening PDF files.

Printing Experience:

- **Adobe Acrobat Reader:** You'll be able to adjust settings before printing.
- **Foxit Reader:** The document will print immediately using your default printer settings, without showing the print settings window.

Important Notes:

- At this time, only **Adobe Acrobat Reader** fully supports all printing features.
- **Foxit Reader** skips the print settings, so it prints directly.
